

Department 117 - Cloverbuds

Class A – Cloverbuds

1. Exhibitors must be enrolled in an official 4-H club
2. Limited to **1** entry for members in **5 year old kindergarten**. Limited to **2** entries for members in **grades 1-2**.
3. Entry tags must be attached to exhibit
4. Cloverbuds are not allowed to exhibit any animals at the county fair.
5. **Posters must not exceed 14" x 22"**. Attach entry tag to upper right corner. Titles and/or picture captions are optional.
6. Individual conference judging will take place Wednesday, 12:00 to 6:00 p.m. **Take exhibits directly to the cloverbud exhibit area. Do not get in the regular judging lines.**
7. Participation ribbon is awarded to each exhibitor and a premium of \$1.50 per entry.

- 1 Four photographs of projects or activities
- 2 Story, poem, or picture about the organization prepared by member
- 3 Any other exhibit about the organization

About Self

Lot Numbers

- 4 A self-portrait (e.g. painting, drawing, felt wall hanging, silhouette, clay)
- 5 A creative article homemade or from a kit (crochet, macramé, creative stitchery, woodworking, craft, puppet, etc.)
- 6 Scrapbook or poster of your pet including pictures and/or care description
- 7 A three-dimensional collage relating to a hobby
- 8 Food item made in the kitchen: bring 3 (cookies, muffins, cupcakes, etc.)
- 9 Exhibit of your hobby
- 10 Homemade toy or musical instrument
- 11 Exhibit made while exploring a 4-H project
- 12 Scrapbook or poster of a farm animal including pictures and/or care description
- 13 Any scale model made from a kit (snap fit or glued)
- 14 Any other exhibit about yourself

About Social Environment

Lot Numbers

- 15 Scrapbook or poster about your community showing places you visited on family or group tours
- 16 First aid kit prepared by member

- 17 Poster or display of how your family recycles items at home
- 18 A picture or model of an unsafe item with a statement explaining why it is not safe
- 19 Any other exhibit about your home, family, friends, or community

About Physical Environment

Lot Numbers

- 20 Four photographs of beauty in the outdoors
- 21 Display of mounted insects, bugs or butterflies
- 22 Houseplant that member has cared for
- 23 Garden exhibit: bring 3 articles of one vegetable (3 beans, 3 peas, etc.; not entire plant)
- 24 Collection of edible seeds, mounted and labeled
- 25 Wildlife poster or article on homes or feeding stations
- 26 Display of 3 or more cut flowers in tin can; cover can with foil
- 27 Any other exhibit about living and non-living things
