- Exhibitors must have completed grade 3 to exhibit in this department.

Exhibit Information

- Exhibits must abide by the Wisconsin county fair health rules.
- Horse must have proof of current negative Coggins
 Test. Please bring the original and 1 copy the copy will be kept in the fair's files. Any horse or pony not meeting these requirements will be required to leave the show grounds. It is highly recommended that horses have up-to-date eastern and western encephalitis vaccine, tetanus, and influenza of the 4-in-1 shot, and rabies.
- All exhibitors must wear an SEI approved helmet with harness securely fastened when mounted or driving a horse or pony on the fairgrounds.

Mini – under 38 inches Pony – 39 – 56 inches Horse – over 56 inches

Definitions

- Halter classes Conformation of the animal is judged.
- <u>Showmanship</u> Exhibitor's ability to show the horse or pony in hand is judged
- <u>Equitation</u> Exhibitor's ability to ride the horse is judged.
- <u>Pleasure</u> Horse or pony is judged as to its performance as a pleasure mount or as a pleasure to drive.
