CLASS A - Market Swine

- Market swine animals will be weighed in on Wednesday.
- Animals will only be weighed one time at the fair. A re-weigh may be
- Three (3) animals may be shown, but no more than 1 animal may be
- Premiums: \$6 \$5 \$4 \$3

CLASS C - Swine Breeding Stock

- Breeding Stock exhibits are not eligible for the auction.
- Lots may be combined if there are less than 5 animals.
- Purebred (registered animals must provide paperwork.
- Pen of feeders can be mixed genders.

Age Classifications:

Junior Yearling: born between January 1 and June 30 of preceding vear.

Senior Sow: born between July 1 and December 31 of preceding year. Senior Spring Sow: born between January 1 and February 28 (or 29) of the exhibit year.

Junior Spring Sow: born in March of exhibit year.

Wednesday Arrival - 3:30 pm

- One (1) entry per lot number may be shown. See exception under Market Class.
- Animal fee is \$5/animal entry.
- No more than **6** animals per exhibitor in this department. Limited to 3 market animals and 3 breeding stock.
- Note: Pen of 3 feeder pigs counts as 1 entry/animal.
- Market animal exhibitors: use market tag numbers (no letters) on online entries and on Check-In form.
- Entries may include purebred, grade, or crossbred hogs.
- A market hog will consist of a barrow or a gilt. A barrow is a male castrated and healed.
- Refer to ATCP 160.08 for age divisions. • All swine exhibitors are eligible to enter an educational exhibit. See Department 110 - Class E.

Exhibit Information:

- Exhibits must abide by WI County Fair Health Rules.
- All animals in this department must have official identification: USDA silver ear tag, USDA 840 ear tag (visual or RFID), Breed Association registered tattoo, ear tag with premises id number and a unique identifier, or
- registered ear notch. • The Animal Check-In Form must be turned in at entry. You MUST list your Premise ID number.
- All animals MUST have a negative PEDV/PRRS test within 90 days of the fair.
- Animals MUST also have a signed Veterinary Health certificate that states that the entire herd was in good
- health at the time of inspection. • Exhibitors must follow all department, county, and state rules listed under general guidelines.
- It is recommended that exhibitors have liability insurance. Weight breaks will be determined by the superintendents
- based on weight at weigh-in. • All breeds will be judged together.
- Hogs should be clean.
