Judging will begin at 3:30 PM on Thursday Showmanship classes will be judged last.

Entry Information:

- Open to youth enrolled in the 4-H Sheep project or youth of other groups doing equivalent work.
- One (1) entry per lot may be shown. See exception in Department J.
- Animal fee is \$5/animal entry
- No more than <u>3</u> animals per exhibitor may be shown in the sheep breed classes
- No more than 3 market lambs per exhibitor may be shown.
- <u>Market animal exhibitors</u>: use market tag numbers (no letters) on online entries and on Check-In form.
- <u>Breeding stock exhibitors</u>: use WI approved ear tag numbers on online entries and on Check-In form.
- Refer to ATCP 160.08 for age divisions.

Exhibit Information:

- Exhibits must abide by WI County Fair Health Rules.
- Exhibitors must follow all department, county, and state rules listed under general guidelines.
- All registered breeding stock must have registration papers available. Papers will be checked.
- ALL sheep must have a scrapie tag.
- The Animal Check-In Form must be turned in at entry. You MUST list your Premise ID number, ear tag number, and scrapie tag information.
- It is recommended that exhibitors have liability insurance.
- All sheep exhibitors are encouraged to be YQCA certified.
- Spray painting of any kind to the head, legs, feet, or body of animals will NOT be allowed.
- All wool breeds including registered Columbias, Corriedales, Rombouillets, and Targhees shall be shown with 2 inches of wool or less.
- Premiums: \$5 \$4 \$3 \$2

Maximum of 6 animals per exhibitor.

Max. 3 animals in breed classes & 3 animals in market classes

CLASS J – Market Classes – all breeds

- Ear tags must be purchased and in the ear by April 15.
- Market sheep will be weighed in on entry day.
- Animals will only be weighed one time at the fair.
- A re-weigh may be done at the discretion of the Superintendent.
- Three (3) animals may be entered in Class J. But no more than 1 animal may be shown in any given weight break.
 No premium will be paid on second animal in any given weight break.
- Weight breaks will be determined by superintendents based on weight at weigh-in.
- All meat breeds shall be shorn to be shown at the fair.
- All belly wool is to be removed on all market lambs.

- Must be pre-entered.
- Entries will be judged Danish.
- Exhibitors are limited to one entry in Class K.
- This is a market animal shown at the fair.
- Ultra-sound judging on Wednesday of fair week.
- 19. Market lamb carcass

CLASS L - Showmanship

- Must be pre-entered.
- Exhibitor may enter one animal in showmanship that is also entered in a regular sheep class.
- Judged Danish.
- Back tag numbers must be worn into ring.
- Premiums: \$3 \$2.50 \$2 \$1.50
- 20. Members in grades 11 and up
- 21. Members in grades 9-10
- 22. Members in grades 7-8
