### **Entry Information**

- Open to youth enrolled in the 4-H poultry project or youth of other groups doing equivalent work.
- Entries are limited by species. Due to space, exhibitors may enter only 6 geese and 6 turkeys.
- Limited to **<u>15 entries</u>** in this department.
- No more than 1 entry per breed / lot number.
- Entries will not be accepted without Premise ID.
- All poultry must be feathered and not younger than 6 weeks of age.
  - ✓ <u>Old female/male</u> are birds hatched <u>before July</u>
    <u>1</u> of the year preceding the exhibit year.
  - ✓ <u>Young female/male</u> are birds hatched <u>after July</u>
    <u>1</u> of the year preceding the exhibit year.
- Animal fee is \$2/entry.

### **Exhibitor Information**

- All exhibits must abide by Wisconsin County Fair animal health rules.
- PULLORUM TESTING All poultry and eggs exhibited at fairs or poultry shows must show that they participate in one of the following:
  - ✓ National Poultry Improvement Plan program
  - ✓ Wisconsin Tested Flock
  - ✓ Wisconsin Associate Flock
  - ✓ Test poultry individually using the Individual Poultry Test Report form.
- Turkeys must be Mycoplasma Gallisepticum Free.
- All poultry, except pigeons, must be certified Pullorum-Typhoid free. Exhibitors must show proof that their birds are Pullorum-free on entry day. Poultry without proof will not be allowed in exhibit building.
- Clipped wings are only permissible on one wing for Muscovy and bantam ducks. All other breeds with clipped wings will be disqualified.

### **Entry Day and Fair Week Information:**

- All exhibitors are required to turn in the Animal Check-In Form to the Superintendent on Entry Day.
- Premise ID is required. <u>http://wiid.org/</u>
- Exhibitors will provide non-breakable feed and water containers.
- Fowl MUST be fed and watered daily.
- Cages MUST be cleaned daily.
- All exhibitors must be present (or provide a substitute) for judging. This includes birds that are judged in their cages. Birds will not be presented to the judge by the superintendent or their assistants.

# **Department 107 - Poultry**

Judging Friday at 8:30 AM

- Exhibitors must present chickens, bantams, and ducks to the judge's table for group conference judging.
- All other fowl will be judged in the cage or beside the cage; exhibitors may be asked to remove their birds.
- Judges will award no premium on inferior fowl or birds improperly classified, even though there is no competition. All specimens will be judged by comparison. The judges will use both the <u>Bantam Standard</u> and <u>The American Standard of Perfection</u> as their guide.
- Market animals will be weighed before 6 PM on entry day.
- FOR SALE signs are allowed AFTER judging is complete.
- All poultry entries must be claimed between 5:30 and 6:30 PM on Sunday.
