Judging on Sunday

Entry Information

- Open to youth enrolled in the 4-H Cats project or youth of other groups doing equivalent work.
- No more than 2 cats per exhibitor one entry is allowed per lot number.
- Long Hair hair coat more than one inch in length
- Short Hair hair coat one inch or less in length
- All Cat exhibitors are eligible to enter educational exhibits. See Dept. 110, Class K.
- Each exhibitor must provide a 4x6 or 5x7 photo of their animal exhibitor is encouraged to be in the photo as well. Photo should be mounted to white or black poster board (8x10). Please have your name and club written on the poster board. Photos should be dropped off at the Exhibits Office (bldg. #5) on entry day Tuesday. Photos are required to receive premiums.

Exhibit Information

- Cats must be vaccinated for rabies and distemper by a licensed veterinarian at least 1 month prior to the date of show. Proof of vaccination must be presented to the superintendent upon entry.
- Pregnant cats subject to giving birth should not be entered in the show.
- Male cats over 8 months of age are not allowed unless they are neutered.
- Remove harness/collar from cat when unattended.
- Cats will be judged on health, grooming, general appearance, etc.
- Youth will be asked questions about the animal as part of the judging.
- Cats should plan to arrive by 9:30 AM on Sunday of the fair.
- Cage judging begins at 10:00 AM.
- Cat Judging begins at 10:30 AM.
- All cats may be taken home immediately after judging is completed.
- Judging will be based on the Danish system.
