All photos must be mounted on poster board. White or black poster board is suggested.

- Mount (2) 4x6 photos onto 8 ½ x 11 poster board or cardstock.
- Mount a 5x7 photo onto 8 ½ x 11 poster board or cardstock.
- Mount an 8x10 photo onto a 11x14 poster board.
- o Entry tag must be attached to the back of poster board
- o Please write your name and club on bottom of poster board.
- No date stamps on photos.
- A photo title is optional and may be written on the BACK of the poster board.
- Photos must be securely attached to poster board using rubber cement or high-quality mounting tape.
