Exhibit Information

- Booths must be in place by 6 p.m. on Tuesday
- · Decorated booth should have a title
- Club/Group name should be displayed
- Booths must be deconstructed on Sunday AFTER 5 PM
- Remove all staples from the walls and discard all trash -- NO exceptions!
- Educational Booth Judging criteria 100 points possible
 - ✓ <u>Workmanship</u> Colors, Prop creation, Scale, Placement of items, Variety of sizes & shapes, and Club name displayed
 - ✓ **Visual** Test/title size, Readability, Neat & uncluttered, and has Dimension
 - ✓ <u>Theme</u> Creative, one central theme, Interpretation of theme, and is complete
 - ✓ <u>Effectiveness</u> Subject matter accurate, Idea shown simply and clearly, does it effectively promote your group or does it effectively educate the public

CLASS A – Educational Booths

- 1. Educational Booth
- 2. Booth promoting your youth organization

Booth size:

- ✓ 6 feet wide, 4 feet deep, and 18 inches off the floor
- ✓ Sides are 4 feet high
- ✓ Back wall is 78 inches
- ✓ Front height is 60"

Notes:

- Each of the judging categories will be assigned points (1-5).
- Educational booths will be evaluated by 3 judges.
- Scores will be averaged.
- Placings will be based on the final scores using the Danish system.
- The top blue will receive a MERIT.
