## Exhibit Information

- Entries must be checked in between Noon and 6 PM on TUESDAY.
- If entered in the wrong category or if directions have not been followed, exhibit will be disqualified or given a lower placing at the discretion of the judge.
- All are welcome to be present and ask questions of the judge after items are judged.


## CLASS A - Field Crops

- Limited to $\underline{\mathbf{7}}$ entries per exhibitor.
- All grain samples must be from previous year or the current year's crop and cannot be treated.
- All sheaf samples must be from the current year's crop and should be tied below the heads and near the bottom end, they should be $21 / 2$ inches in diameter at the upper end.
- All exhibits must be prepared for display prior to arriving at the fair.

- MUST specify variety on back of entry tag.
